For the Libbie Braverman
Award for Teachers

The Libbie Braverman Award recognizes a teacher who has demonstrated dedication and devotion to teaching and has significantly contributed to developing methods or materials to the Jewish education profession.



Any teacher in a Cleveland Jewish school, pre-school through grade 12 is eligible for nomination.



Nomination must be made by a parent whose child is currently enrolled in the school.



Parents should submit a one-page letter to the Awards Committee of the Jewish Education Center of Cleveland describing how the nominee has enriched their child's learning through innovative teaching.

The winner will be announced at the JECC Annual Meeting.
